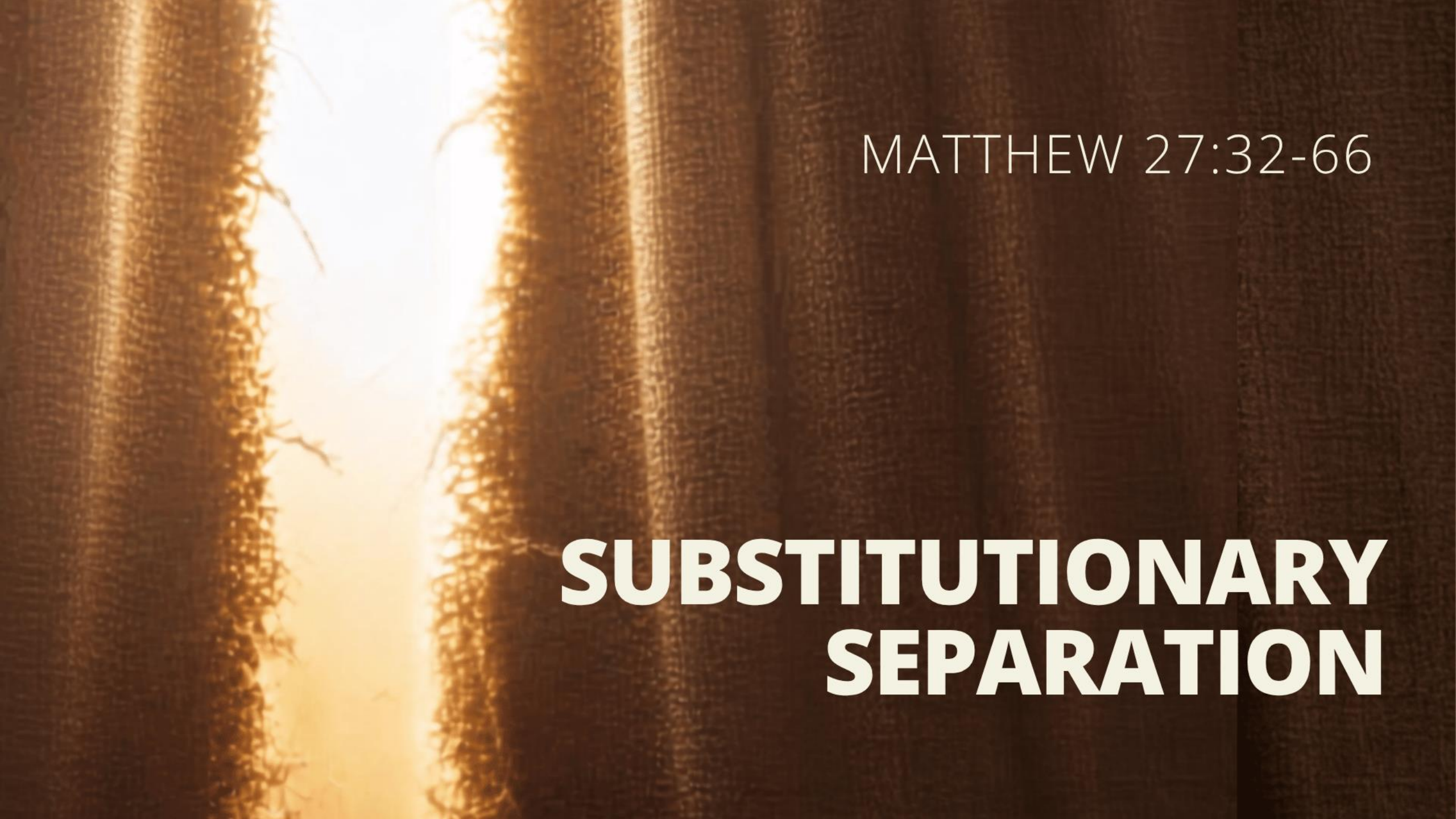

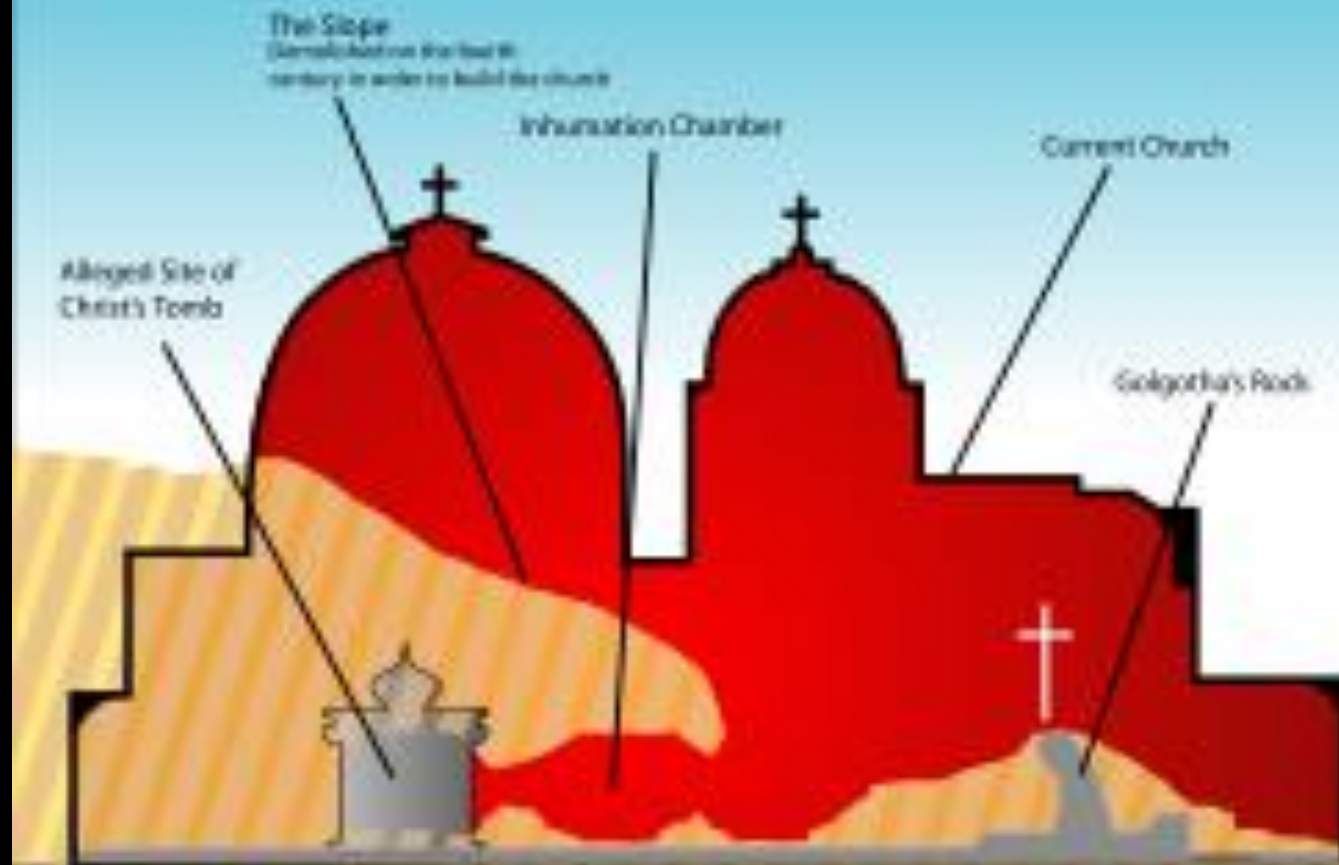
Matt 27:33

My God, my God, why have You forsaken me, and *why are You* so far from helping me, and from the words of my groaning?”

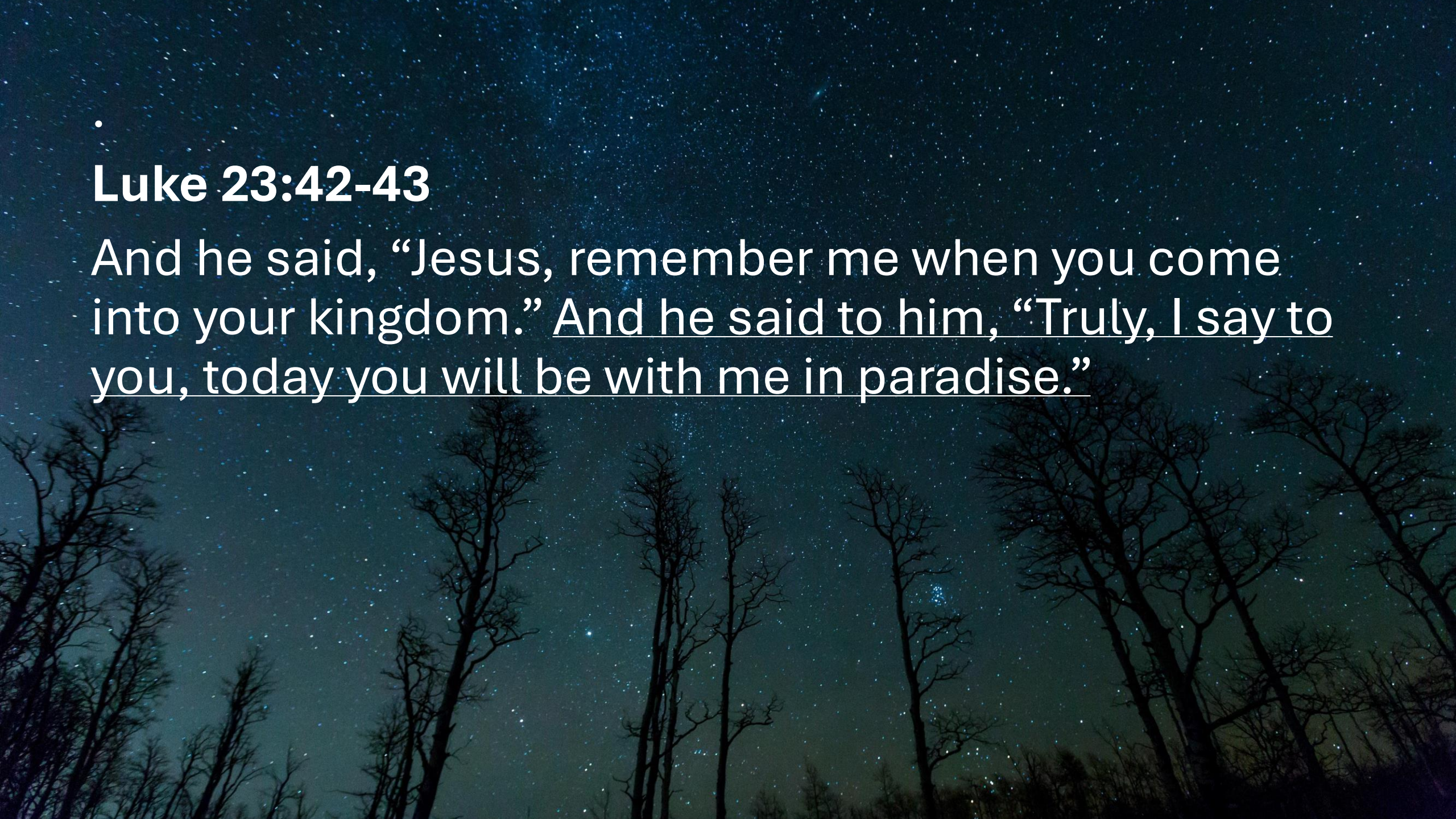
Psalm 31:5
